## TITLE III-DISCLOSURE OF RESEARCH INFORMATION

Sec. S01. (a)(1) The President's Binmedical Research Panel (established by scction 201(a) of the National C'ancer Act Amendments of 1974 (Public Law 03-352)) and the National Commission for the Protection. of Iluman Subjects of Biomedical and Behavioral Research (established by section 201 of the National Rescarch Acf (Public Law 93-3.4S)) shall each conduct an ineestigation and study of the implicalion of the disclosure to the public of information coniained in research protocols, research hypotheses, and rescarch designs obtained by the Secretary of Health, Elucation, and Welfare (hereinafter in the subsection referred to as the "Secretary") in connection with an application or proposal submitted, during the period beginning Jannary 1, 1975, and ending December 31, 1975, to the Secretary for a trant, fellowship, or coniract under the Public Health Scruce Act. In making such investigation and study the Panel and the Commission shall each determine the following:

(B) The purposes for which information disclosed by the Secretary pursuant to such requests was used.
(C) The effcct of the disclosure of such information on- (i) proprietary interests in the research protocol, hypothesis,
design from which such information was disclosed and on patent rights;
(ii) the ability of peer review systems to insure high quality federally funded research; and
(iii) the (I) protection of the public against research which presents an unreasonable risk to human subjects of such rescarch and (II) the adequacy of informed consent procedures. (2)(A) Not Later than May 31, 1976 , the Panel shall complete the investigation ond sturdy requirel to be mate by the Panel by paragraph (1), and, not later than Jone 30, 1976, the Panel shall submit to the Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Labor and r'ublic Welfare of the Senate a report on such investigation and study. The report shall contain such recommendations for legistation as the I'anel deems appropriale.
(13) Not later than Normber 80,1976 , the Commission shall complete the imestigation and study requircal to be made by the Commission by paragraph (1), and, not laler than Incember 31, 1976, the Commission shall submit to the Commitice on Sntrrstate and foreign Commerre of the
House of hepresentatire and Compite of the Senate a report on suel investigation and shady. The report shall contain such recommendations for legistation as the Commission decms appropiale.
