**Summer retreat of a Prussian ruler, Schloss Sanssouci** bespeaks the French tastes of Frederick the Great. In the 1740's he designed the rococo residence with French floor plans and named it "Castle Without Care." Tourists by the thousands visit the palace in Potsdam, outside West Berlin in East Germany.

The statistics are truly appalling. Between 1936 and 1945, the Nazis herded 200,000 persons into the camp—political undesirables, Jews, and captured Russian soldiers; 100,000 of them were killed by shooting or hanging. Of 20,000 Russian prisoners brought here, 18,000 were murdered.

Jürgen Toft and I drove to Sachsenhausen early one rainy Sunday afternoon. A gray mist hung over the camp as we arrived. Built in the form of a huge walled triangle about

2,000 feet long on each side, it sits in a piney forest. On each corner of the triangle and at regular intervals along the wall are watchtowers that once housed Hitler's elite guard, the Schutzstaffel. On all sides today I saw Russian soldiers, members of the occupation army, now living in the former SS barracks.

Prisoners were quartered communally in one-story frame barracks 100 feet long and 30 feet wide. Around a roll-call square, 86 such barracks were arranged in the shape of a fan.

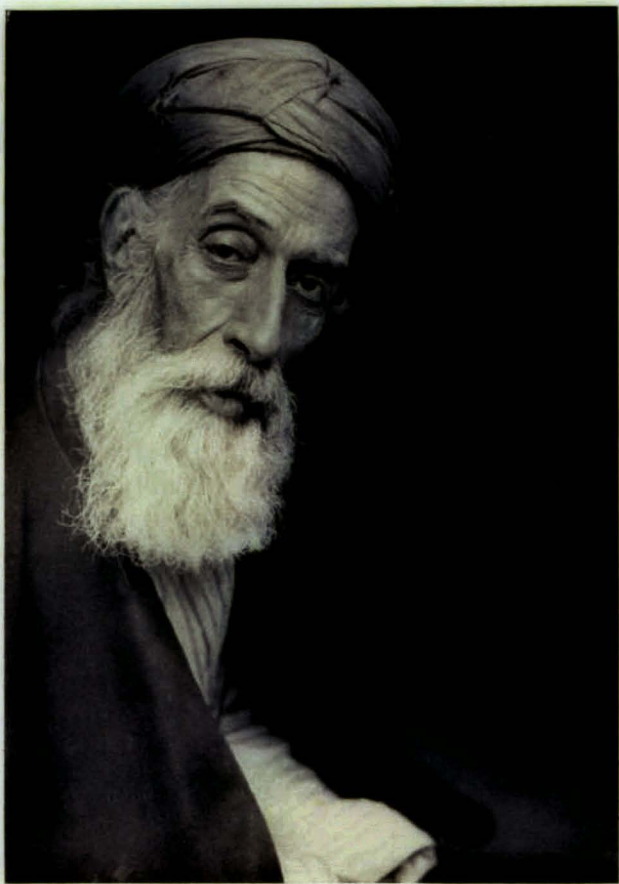

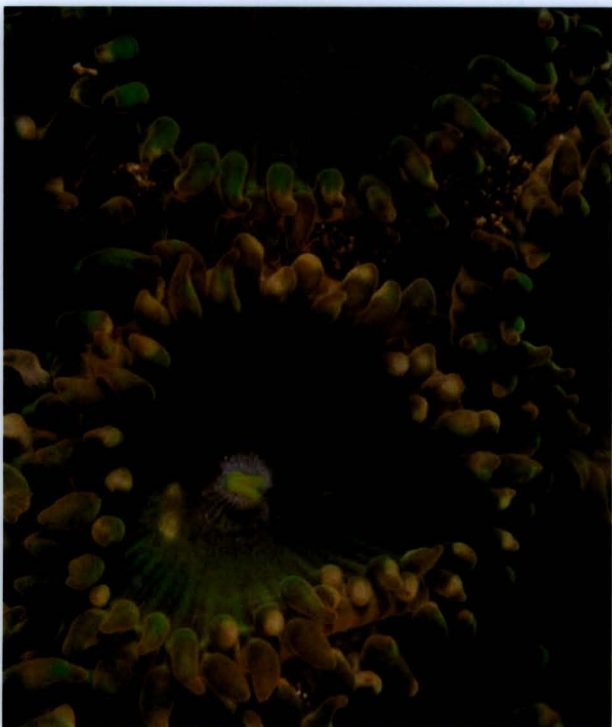

The years of Nazi oppression still darken the memories of Berliners. After the war, Bertolt Brecht, the antifascist playwright, settled in East Berlin and founded one of Europe's noted theaters, the Berliner Ensemble. Today his widow runs the theater. In recent years it has played a smash hit to packed houses: *The Resistible Rise of Arturo Ui*, a powerful indictment of the Nazi era (pages 16-17). Oddly, regulations, which permitted me to photograph the play, forbade my making

pictures of the audience responding to it.

A stronger indictment of the Nazis lies not far away. The Ulbricht government, as part of its propaganda, pays fastidious attention to the details of the Nazi era. The infamous concentration camp called Sachsenhausen lies a half-hour drive to the north of the city. It is maintained as a memorial. On Sundays, young East Berliners flock there, along with tourists from the Soviet Union, Hungary, Czechoslovakia, and Poland.



the missing facial bones. Though shattered like the rest of the skull, beside them lay both halves of a tooth-studded upper jaw.

Analysis of the teeth and of pelvic, arm, and leg bones recovered later showed that this fossil skull was that of a boy, no more than 12 years old at death.

During the next three weeks we had the exquisite pleasure of unearthing almost an entire *Homo erectus* skeleton, the first recovered of such antiquity—1.6 million years old—and the earliest set of one individual's bones found in situ. Limb, rib, and collar-bones appeared, along with vertebrae and the lower jaw, one of the very few ever to be matched to its skull. To find a more complete skeleton, we must jump forward in time to 100,000 years ago, when Neanderthal man began to bury his dead.

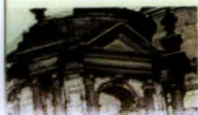
This spectacular find dramatically confirms the antiquity of the human form. In its parts and proportion only the skull of the Lake Turkana boy would look odd to someone untrained in anatomy. The rest of his skeleton, essentially human, differs only subtly from that of a modern boy.

And too, because it is a youth's skeleton and so complete, it offers us a unique glimpse of growth and development in early humans. At five feet four inches tall, the boy from Turkana was surprisingly large compared with modern boys his age; he could well have grown to six feet. Suitably clothed and with a cap to obscure his low forehead and beetle brow, he would probably go unnoticed in a crowd today.

This find combines with previous discoveries of *Homo erectus* to contradict a long-held idea that humans have grown larger over the millennia. Our ancestors on the African savanna may have been much taller than we ever imagined. Indeed, we may have reached our present general size more than a million and a half years ago, with some populations in poorer environments becoming smaller fairly recently.

Only luck, the presence of a supply of underground water, and the scanty shade of a few parched thorn trees first drew us to the Nariokotome River and the skeleton of the boy from Lake Turkana. During the 1985 excavation, we began to uncover the last of the missing bones, adding another page to his biography—and to mankind's. □

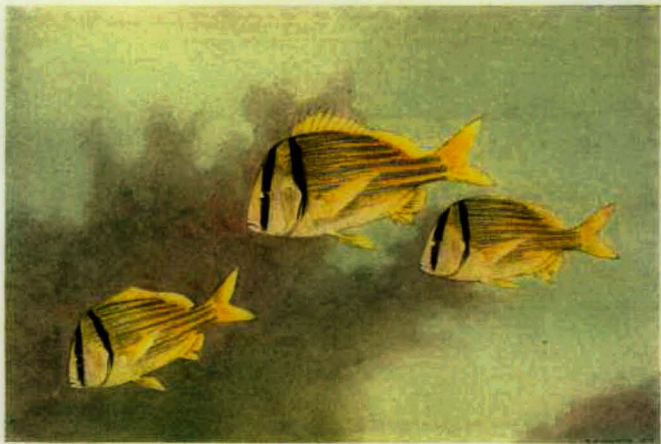






THE SQUIRREL FISH OR SOLDATO (*Halocentrus ascensionis*)

These bright hued habitants of the tropical seas are to be found in the waters surrounding the Bermudas, Florida, the West Indies, St. Helena and Ascension Island. They reach a length of two feet, and are considered a good food fish.



THE PORK FISH (*Anisotremus virginicus*)

This important food fish, found from Florida to Brazil, reaches a length of fifteen inches, and lives in large numbers about coral heads and reefs. It is easily trapped by market fishermen.



THE SERGEANT MAJOR OR COW PILOT (*Abudefduf saxatilis*)

As its name, *saxatilis*, implies, this inhabitant of tropical American waters lives among the rocks. It attains a length of six inches and is not used for food.

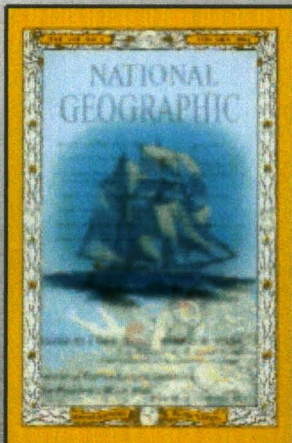


THE RAINBOW PARROT-FISH (*Pseudoceros guatemalensis*)

Weighing as much as sixty pounds, the Rainbow Parrot-fish is the largest of its family. The fish is soft but of very good flavor. It is found from the Florida Keys to Rio de Janeiro, and lives on mollusks, worms, and several species of algae.

## Install the Ink Cartridges



Follow these ink cartridge precautions:

- Remove the yellow tape seal from the top of the ink cartridges or you'll permanently damage them. Don't remove the clear seals on the bottom or ink will leak out.
- Don't open an ink cartridge clamp to remove a cartridge except to replace it with a new one. Once you remove a cartridge, you can't reuse it, even if it contains ink.
- Never turn off the printer when the power light is flashing, unless the printer hasn't moved or made any noise for more than 5 minutes.

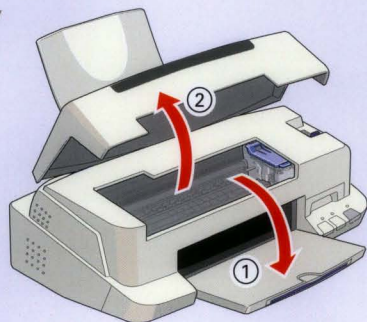

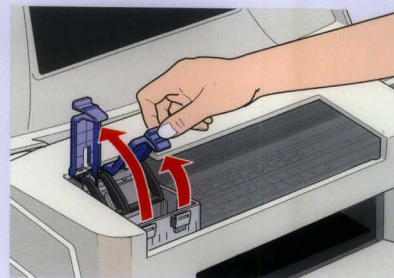

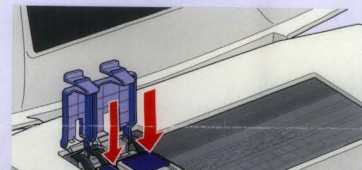

# 2 Install the Software

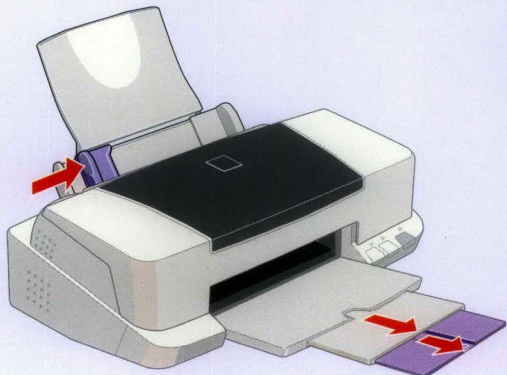

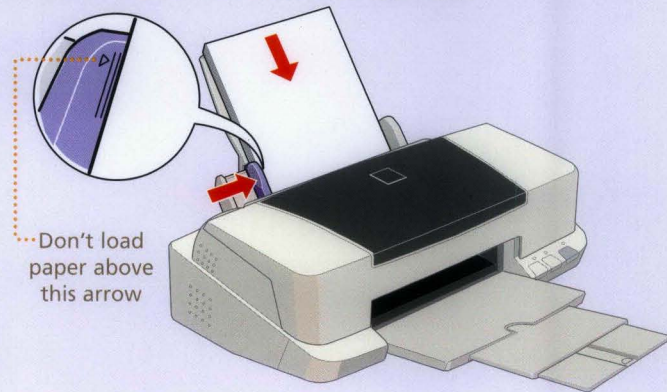

# Windows 95/98/NT 4.0 with Parallel Connection

- 1** Turn on your printer, if necessary. Then turn on your computer.

- 2** Insert your printer software CD-ROM.
- 3** Double-click the  **My Computer** icon on your desktop.

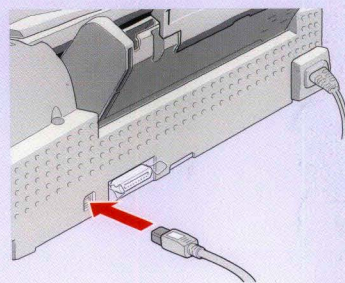
## Connecting to a USB Port

(Recommended connection; only for Windows® 98, iMac™, and Power Macintosh® G3 systems; see "System Requirements" in the *Printer Basics* book for details)

- 1 Make sure the printer and computer are turned off.
- 2 Connect the  end of the USB cable to your printer's USB port.
- 3 Connect the  end of the cable to your computer's USB port or a first tier USB hub port.



If you're using a USB hub, connect the printer to the first tier of the hub or the printer may malfunction. If the printer doesn't work there, connect it directly to a USB port on your computer.

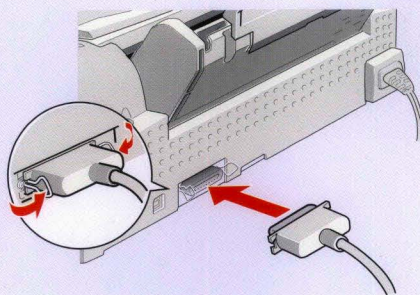





- 1 Make sure the printer and computer are turned off.
- 2 Connect the parallel cable to your printer's parallel port. Then secure it with the wire clips.
- 3 Connect the other end of the cable to your computer's built-in parallel port and secure it as necessary.




If your computer has multiple parallel ports, connect your printer to the built-in port (LPT1). To use a different port, see Windows help. To configure your computer to match your printer's maximum speed, enable ECP/DMA mode, if possible. See your computer documentation.



## Turn on the Printer

- 1 Plug the printer's power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.
- 2 Press the  power button to turn on the printer. The  power light flashes and the  black and  color ink out lights come on. The ink cartridge holders move left into loading position.



Don't use an outlet that is controlled by a wall switch or timer, or one on the same circuit as a large appliance, to avoid damaging the printer's power supply. Always use the  power button to turn the printer on or off. Never use an external switch, such as a power strip switch.

# 3 Print an Image

Now that you've set up your printer, you're ready to print.

For a quick lesson, run the EPSON Guided Printing Exercise and follow the steps to print this sample color image:

The instructions tell you how to load sample paper from the EPSON Photo Quality Media Pack included with your printer.
