AFFIDAVIT OF JERRY GREENBERG

1. My name is Jerry Greenberg. I am a plaintiff in the above-captioned action. The statements in this affidavit are based on my personal knowledge.

2. On December 18, 1985, the National Geographic Society ("the Society") conveyed to me "all right, title and interest, including copyright" to photographs taken by me that had appeared in articles in the Society's monthly magazine in 1962, 1968 and 1971. Ex. A.¹ In 1988 I filed a Certificate of Recordation with the U.S. Copyright Office to give public notice of my ownership of the copyrights encompassed in the conveyance document. Ex. B.

¹ All exhibits referenced in this affidavit are attached hereto and incorporated herein.

3. I filed three renewal certificates with the Copyright Office, each relating to, and limited to, the photographs published in the 1962, 1968 and 1971 issues of the monthly magazine discussed above. Exhibit E.

4. On June 14, 1989, the Society agreed to convey to me "all rights" to photographs taken by me for inclusion in an article that was published in the Society's monthly magazine in July of 1990. Ex. C. The 1989 agreement said that "all photographs will be returned to you along with all rights to said photographs." Ex. C. In the agreement, certain conditions were attached to the conveyance of rights, all of which I complied with. All photographs were returned to me by the Society by July 1990 (color plates for printing the article already had been prepared).

5. In July of that year, after all of those photographs, and the rights to those photographs, had been returned to me, I filed with the Copyright Office a Certificate of Copyright Registration with respect to photographs used in the July 1990 article. Ex. D. In box 2 of the registration form is a request to describe the "nature of the material created by this author in which copyright is claimed." In that space I inserted "photographs on pages 114, 115, 118, 119, 120, 121, 122, 123, 126, 127, 130, 132." I intended to register nothing else.

6. On the 1990 registration form, Exhibit D, in box 6, is a reference to a "derivative work" that originally appeared in the January 1962 magazine, and which consisted of a composite panoramic view, made from five photographs, of the Carysfort Reef in the Pennekamp State Park (an underwater park). That panoramic view was re-printed in the July 1990 article on pages 118, 119 and 120. When I completed the form, I did not know whether the panoramic view from the 1962 article legally qualified as a derivative work. On those same pages in the

1990 article appeared a single photograph, taken in 1989 from the same location as in the 1962 photographs, intended to show how the Carysfort Reef had disintegrated with time. The "reconstruction" mentioned in box 6 of the 1990 registration referenced the single photograph taken in 1989, because the photograph reconstructed the 1962 view.

7. Another comparative set of photographs, both showing the same view of the Molasses Reef, appeared on pages 121, 122 and 123 in the 1990 article. The first set was made by me in 1983. The second, shot at the same spot underwater, I made in 1989. Each set consisted of two photographs spliced into a panoramic view of the Molasses Reef.

8. In January 1962, 31 separate photographs taken by me, and encompassed in the 1985 transfer of rights, were published in the Society's monthly magazine. The number 31 does not include the cover photograph for that issue, which displayed a photograph included within the article in that issue. The number 31 does include the composite panoramic view of the Carysfort Reef, which is counted as one photograph. Copies of my photographs in that issue of the magazine are attached as Exhibit F.


9. In February 1968, 10 separate photographs taken by me, and encompassed in the 1985 transfer of rights, were published in the Society's monthly magazine. The number 10 does not include the cover photograph for that issue, which displayed a photograph included within the article in that issue. Copies of my photographs in that issue of the magazine are attached as Exhibit G.

10. In May 1971, 8 separate photographs taken by me, and encompassed in the 1985 transfer of rights, were published in the Society's monthly magazine. Copies of my photographs in that issue of the magazine are attached as Exhibit H.

11. In July 1990, 12 separate photographs taken by me, and encompassed in the 1989 agreement to transfer rights to me, were published in the Society's monthly magazine. The number 12 includes the single-photo panoramic view of the Carysfort Reef that I shot in 1989. The number 12 includes the two panoramic views of the Molasses Reef described in paragraph 5 above, each of which is counted as one photograph. The number 12 does not include the panoramic view of Carysfort Reef which had been published originally in the January 1962 article and was re-printed in the July 1990 article. Copies of my photographs in the July 1990 issue of the magazine are attached as Exhibit J.

12. After rights to the photographs described in the paragraphs above were returned to me, I had various opportunities to make other commercial use of the photographs. I licensed the use of certain of the photographs to an advertising agency and to a publisher, for agreed compensation. Numerous photographs among those discussed in this affidavit have been re-printed by my wife and myself in various books marketed through our own company, Seahawk Press, particularly in the period between 1985 and 1997. Still other overtures were made to me in that period by other parties regarding the republication of certain of the photographs, but for various reasons I declined those proposals.

Dear Jerry:

This letter, when signed by both parties, will constitute your agreement as a freelance photographer with the National Geographic Society ("NGS") to photograph Pennekamp Reef Park (#05738) for National Geographic Magazine.

1) This assignment will extend for 20 days. Your compensation will be at the rate of:

(a) \$350 per day for days spent shooting or in field research (i.e., research directly germane to producing the coverage); and

(b) one half of the above rate per day for days spent in travel (including arranging or waiting for travel); on standby, in the field or elsewhere; or in consulting with NGS editors ("editorial days").

2) Your compensation is subject to the following provisions:

(a) Work beyond the anticipated assignment days mentioned above will be compensated at the same daily rates as above. Should it become necessary to extend this assignment for additional days, you must get authorization to do so from the Director of Photography, the Assistant Director of Photography or the Illustrations Editor assigned to the project.

(b) The total compensation paid to you for this assignment will be applied against the page rate of \$300 a page for the National Geographic Magazine, or a minimum of \$100 a transparency, whichever is greater.

3) When working for NGS, you will carefully avoid doing similar work for publications which NGS would consider to be editorially competitive with it. You will advise NGS promptly of any possible conflict of interest that may develop. You also will take care not to grant any prepublication interviews or assist in any way in the preparation of any prepublication articles or other press coverage in any medium which would reveal the subject matter, editorial content or the scheduling of an assignment, article or story for the National Geographic Society.

EXHIBIT C

4) By this Agreement you warrant to NGS that publication of any photographs taken by you on this assignment will not infringe upon any right of privacy, copyright or any other proprietary right of a third party.

5) All photographs taken by you under this Agreement will be considered as specially commissioned for use by NGS and upon creation all rights, including the copyright and world publication rights, to these photographs will automatically, by virtue of this Agreement, be deemed transferred exclusively and indefinitely to NGS, subject to the following provisions:

(a) all photographs will be returned to you along with all rights to said photographs under the following conditions: (i) none may be made available to anyone for publication until sixty days after NGS has published its selections; (ii) it is understood that any necessary rights clearance or release for non-NGS publication is your independent responsibility; and (iii) NGS may make and retain copies of some of the photographs ("reference selects") for reference purposes only in its Illustrations Library;

(b) you grant to NGS without additional charge the right to use your name, likeness and biographical material in connection with the publication of any photographs retained by NGS under this Agreement;

(c) NGS may crop your photographs.

6) You undertake all work under this Agreement as an independent contractor. NGS assumes no responsibility for your health, safety or property or that of any person accompanying or assisting you. While on assignment in the field you will be covered by NGS's accident insurance policy, which provides a payment of \$200,000 to you in the event of total disability or to your beneficiary, specified below, in the event of death, and lesser coverage for other injuries. The policy also provides up to \$10,000 for excess medical coverage, i.e. for costs beyond those covered by your own personal accident and health coverages. The above coverage is restricted to you alone.

7) While you are on NGS assignment, NGS will pay or reimburse you for all reasonable expenses and will supply you with film and processing. At the close of this assignment you will provide NGS with a diary of your activities while on assignment, including an accurate and complete record of the people and places represented in your photographs. A final accounting of expenses, supplies, etc. for an assignment will be due to NGS no later than two weeks after the work on that assignment is finished. Failure to reconcile expense/supply accounts with NGS in a timely manner may impede payment of fees.

8) Your work on this assignment will not be considered complete until so indicated by the Illustrations Editor. At the end of the assignment you will deliver to NGS all photographs you have taken on this assignment as well as complete captions for your photographs. You will be available for a projection session with the editor to explain your work. If you are

called back for editorial consultation, you will be paid a fee of \$175 per day plus expenses.

9) This agreement cannot be modified except by written instrument signed by both of us.
