**TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING
CHANGES IN PATENT AND
TRADEMARK LAWS AND IN
THE CIVIL RIGHTS OF INSTI-
TUTIONALIZED PERSONS ACT**

Mr. BAKER. Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent that the Judiciary Committee be discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3345, and I ask for its immediate consideration.

The PRESIDING OFFICER. Without objection, it is so ordered.

The bill will be stated by title.

The assistant legislative clerk read as follows:

A bill (H.R. 3345) to make technical and conforming changes in the patent and trademark laws and in the Civil Rights of Institutionalized Persons Act.

The PRESIDING OFFICER. The bill is before the Senate and open to amendment. If there be no amendment to be offered, the question is on the third reading and passage of the bill.

The bill (H.R. 3345) was ordered to a third reading, was read the third time, and passed.
