MR. DELANEY, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution;
which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to move that the House resolve itself into
3 the Committee of the Whole House on the State of the
4 Union for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 10966) to fix
5 the fees payable to the Patent Office and for other purposes.
6 After general debate, which shall be confined to the bill, and
7 shall continue not to exceed one hour, to be equally divided
8 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority mem-
9 ber of the Committee on the Judiciary, the bill shall be read
10 for amendment under the five-minute rule. At the conclusion
11 of the consideration of the bill for amendment, the Com-
12 mittee shall rise and report the bill to the House with such

1 amendments as may have been adopted, and the previous
2 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amend-
3 ments thereto to final passage without intervening motion
4 except one motion to recommit.
