## A BILL

Granting an extension of patent to the United Daughters of the Confederacy.

- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That a certain design patent issued by the United States
- 4 Patent Office of date November 8, 1898, being patent num-
- 5 bered 29611, is hereby renewed and extended for a period
- 6 of fourteen years from and after the passage of this Act,
- 7 with all the rights and privileges pertaining to the same,
- 8 being generally known as the insignia of the United Daugh-
- 9 ters of the Confederacy: Provided, however, That no per-
- 10 son who has manufactured the design of said patent between
- 11 the 8th day of November, 1905, and the date of the passage

- of this Act shall be held liable for infringement of this 1
- 2 patent by reason of the continued manufacture and sale
- 3 thereof.
