Mr. KASTENMEIER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend title 35, United States Code, to make certain clarifications with respect to joint inventors.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 116 of title 35, United States Code, is amended
4 by amending the first paragraph to read as follows:

5 “When two or more persons have contributed to making
6 an invention, they shall apply for patent jointly and each
7 shall sign the application and make the required oath, except
8 as otherwise provided in this title. Joint inventors need not
9 have made a contribution to each claim contained in the ap-
10 plication.”.

1 SEC. 2. The amendment made by the first section of this
2 Act shall apply to any unexpired United States patent grant-
3 ed before the date of the enactment of this Act and to any
4 United States patent granted on or after such date.
