#### AN ACT

Providing for the extension of patent numbered D-119,187.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That (a) a certain design patent issued by the United States
- 4 Patent Office of date February 27, 1940, being patent num-
- 5 bered D-119,187, which is the insignia of the Massachusetts
- 6 Department of the United American Veterans of the United
- 7 States of America, Incorporated, is hereby renewed and
- 8 extended for an additional period of fourteen years from and
- 9 after the date of enactment of this Act, with all the rights
- 10 and privileges pertaining to the same, being generally
- 11 known as the insignia of the Massachusetts Department

- 1 of the United American Veterans of the United States of
- 2 America, Incorporated; (b) no person who has manufac-
- 3 tured the design of such patent between February 27, 1954,
- 4 and the date of the enactment of this Act shall be held liable
- 5 for infringement of such patent by reason of the continued
- 6 manufacture and sale thereof.
