

## Public Law 88-397 88th Congress, H. R. 9833 August 1, 1964

## An Act

78 STAT. 378.

Granting a renewal of patent numbered D-162,975, relating to a medal of the American Legion.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That a certain American Legion design patent issued by the United States Patent Office, dated April medal. 17, 1951, being patent numbered D-162,975, is hereby renewed and Patent renewal. extended for a period of fourteen years from and after the date of approval of this Act, with all the rights and privileges pertaining to the same, being generally known as a medal of the American Legion.
