

Public Law 89-295 89th Congress, H. R. 7888 October 23, 1965

An Act

79 STAT. 1070

Providing for the extension of patent numbered D-119,187.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That (a) a certain United American design patent issued by the United States Patent Office of date Febru-Veterans of the ary 27, 1940, being patent numbered D-119,187, which is the insignia United States of of the Massachusetts Department of the United American Veterans of the United States of America, Incorporated, is hereby renewed and extended for an additional period of fourteen years from and after the date of enactment of this Act, with all the rights and privileges pertaining to the same, being generally known as the insignia of the Massachusetts Department of the United American Veterans of the United States of America, Incorporated; (b) no person who has manufactured the design of such patent between February 27, 1954, and the date of the enactment of this Act shall be held liable for infringement of such patent by reason of the continued manufacture and sale thereof.
