AN ACT

Granting an extension of patent to the United Daughters of the Confederacy.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That (a) a certain design patent issued by the United States
- 4 Patent Office of date November 8, 1898, being patent num-
- 5 bered 29,611 which is the insignia of the United Daughters
- 6 of the Confederacy, which was renewed and extended for a
- 7 period of fourteen years by Public Law Numbered 220.
- 8 Seventy-seventh Congress, approved August 18, 1941, is
- 9 hereby renewed and extended for an additional period of
- 10 fourteen years from and after the date of enactment of this
- 11 Act, with all the rights and privileges pertaining to the same,

- 1 being generally known as the insignia of the United
- 2 Daughters of the Confederacy.
- 3 (b) No person who has manufactured the design of such
- 4 patent between August 18, 1955, and the date of the enact-
- 5 ment of this Act shall be held liable for infringement of such
- 6 patent by reason of the continued manufacture and sale
- 7 thereof.
