A BILL

Granting an extension of patent to the United Daughters of the Confederacy.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That (a) a certain design patent issued by the United States
- 4 Patent Office of date November 8, 1898, being patent num-
- 5 bered 29,611, which was renewed and extended for a period
- 6 of fourteen years by Public Law Numbered 220, Seventy-
- 7 seventh Congress, approved August 18, 1941, is hereby
- 8 renewed and extended for an additional period of fourteen
- 9 years from and after the date of enactment of this Act, with
- 10 all the rights and privileges pertaining to the same, being



- 1 generally known as the insignia of the United Daughters of
- 2 the Confederacy.
- 3 (b) No person who has manufactured the design of such
- 4 patent between August 18, 1955, and the date of the enact-
- 5 ment of this Act shall be held liable for infringement of such
- 6 patent by reason of the continued manufacture and sale
- 7 thereof.
