Mr. ROBERTSON introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

Granting an extension of patent to the United Daughters of the Confederacy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That (a) a certain design patent issued by the United States
4 Patent Office of date November 8, 1898, being patent num-
5 bered 29,611, which was renewed and extended for a period
6 of fourteen years by Public Law Numbered 220, Seventy-
7 seventh Congress, approved August 18, 1941, is hereby
8 renewed and extended for an additional period of fourteen
9 years from and after the date of enactment of this Act, with
10 all the rights and privileges pertaining to the same, being

1 generally known as the insignia of the United Daughters of
2 the Confederacy.

3 (b) No person who has manufactured the design of such
4 patent between August 18, 1955, and the date of the enact-
5 ment of this Act shall be held liable for infringement of such
6 patent by reason of the continued manufacture and sale
7 thereof.
