
Pursuant to our discussions at the last meeting of the Interagency Working Group, I am enclosing representative collaborative agreements and policy statements employed by the National Cancer Institute (NCI).

The following documents are enclosed:

1. Agreement whereby Government given access to company's proprietary process.
2. Agreement whereby Government and company each contribute expertise to achieve a well-defined goal. Company to receive a royalty-free exclusive license to inventions made under the Agreement in return for supplying reagents.
- 3A, 3B. Agreements whereby Government and company each contribute expertise to achieve a well-defined goal. Company to receive a royalty-free exclusive license for inventions made under the Agreement in return for furnishing financial support to Government laboratory.
4. Agreement whereby Government and Company each contribute expertise to achieve a well-defined goal. Company to receive a royalty-bearing exclusive license for inventions made under the Agreement.
5. NCI Policy on Joint Endeavors with Commercial Organizations.
6. Descriptive information on FAES which is used to receive monies from non-Government entities.
7. DHHS Policy on Outside Work and Activities.
8. Sample Consulting Agreement for NIH Employees.
