

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FOREWORD

It is with great pleasure that we submit to you the results of the "AUTM Licensing Survey" for Fiscal Years 1993, 1992, and 1991. This survey was commissioned by the Association of University Technology Managers ("AUTM") with approval from the 1994 AUTM Board of Trustees, and under the direction of William Hostetler (AUTM President), Eugene K. Schuler, Jr. (AUTM Statistical Committee Chair), and Jean A. Mahoney (AUTM Publications Committee Chair).

Appreciation is extended to the AUTM members who participated in this survey for the second year in a row, and to the new institutions that joined in the AUTM Licensing Survey for the first time this year. Your timely and complete responses are to be commended.

The "Executive Summary and Selected Data" report provides an overview of the larger, more detailed report (referred to hereafter as the "full report"), and includes 1993 aggregate totals and selected data from the full report. The data summarized in the full report updates the previously reported figures for Fiscal Years 1991 and 1992, and presents new data accrued for Fiscal Year 1993.

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Introduction

The "AUTM Licensing Survey" was conducted by the Association of University Technology Managers, Inc. ("AUTM") to gather data from U.S. and Canadian institutions on their technology transfer programs. The survey covers a large range of topics, including staffing levels, sponsored research expenditures, startups initiated, licensing activity, gross royalties received and paid to other institutions, expenditures and reimbursements for legal fees, and statistics on invention disclosures, patent filings, and issued patents.

Respondents to the survey were requested to provide a *best estimate* to each question if an exact response was not known. In a few instances, best estimates were provided, and, at times, responses were rounded to the nearest thousands or millions. If a survey response was provided on a confidential basis, the institution's name is reflected in the reports as "Name Confidential." Not available data are noted as "N.A."

The AUTM Licensing Survey was first conducted in 1993 to gather data for Fiscal Years 1991 and 1992, and readministered in 1994 to accrue data for Fiscal Year 1993. The full report presents the data reported by the participating institutions for each year surveyed.

Survey Coverage

The survey population for Fiscal Year 1993 consisted of 250 institutions, which included AUTM regular members¹ and selected affiliate members.² Follow-up efforts were heavily concentrated toward the top 100 universities (Source: NSF Table B-4, Federal Obligations for Research and Development to the 100 Universities and Colleges Receiving the Largest Amounts...), resulting in an 85% response rate from these top institutions. Overall, 63% of those contacted responded, representing 158 organizations for Fiscal Year 1993, including: 117 U.S. Universities, 26 U.S. Hospitals and Research Institutes, 12 Canadian Institutions, and 3 Third-Party Patent Management Firms.

Summary of Results

In the full report, the results have been summarized for each fiscal year (Fiscal Years 1993, 1992, and 1991) by sample population.³ The sample populations have been separated into the following institutional categories: U.S. Universities, U.S. Hospitals & Research Institutes,⁴ Canadian Institutions, and Third-Party Patent Management Firms.⁵ The full report presents data for the survey participants in five different sections: one section for each of the four institutional categories listed above, and a totals section. In addition a new table in the full study reflects the FY 1993 data by state for participating U.S. institutions, including U.S. Universities, U.S. Hospitals and Research Institutes, and U.S. Patent

5. *Government agencies were not surveyed in Fiscal Year 1993, and therefore, have not been made a part of this year's report.*
6. *The rate used for the conversion from Canadian to U.S. dollars for Fiscal Year 1993 was \$1.29 and was obtained from the Bank of Canada. The rates used for the conversion from Canadian to U.S. dollars for Fiscal Years 1991 and 1992 were \$1.20 and \$1.25, respectively, and were provided by Dr. James W. Murray, 1993 AUTM Vice President-Canada. In all instances, these rates reflect the annual average for the year.*
7. *When providing data for Fiscal Year 1993, some institutions identified significant changes in the reporting of their Fiscal Year 1991 and 1992 data. These data have been changed to reflect modified data submitted by these institutions, and, as a result, the Fiscal Years 1991 and 1992 totals printed in this year's report may be slightly different than those previously published.*
8. *The gross royalties received for both Fiscal Years 1991 and 1992 shown in this report of \$221,607,337 and \$287,384,577, respectively, are lower than the previously printed numbers due to removal of government agencies from the report. The National Institutes of Health accounted for \$16 million and \$12 million in FY 1991 and FY 1992, respectively. These gross royalties reflect those distributed by Research Corporation Technologies to universities (\$29 Million in FY 1991 and \$32 Million in FY 1992), and royalties distributed by Stanford University to the University of California System (approximately \$7 Million in each FY 1991 and FY 1992). Adjusting for these figures, the adjusted gross royalties received for FY 1991 and FY 1992 become \$185,607,337 and \$248,384,577, respectively. Gross royalties received for Fiscal Year 1993 were reported at \$380,212,419. Adjusting for the amount of royalties received that were paid to other institutions (\$57,366,590), the adjusted gross royalties received for Fiscal Year 1993 becomes \$322,845,829.*
9. *The definitions for Total Sponsored Research Expenditures, Federal Government Expenditures, and Industry Expenditures were modified with the survey for Fiscal Year 1993 to request annual expenditure amounts as opposed to annual sponsored funding levels.*
10. *The University of California System and the SUNY Research Foundation have modified the reporting of their system data to reflect one combined response for all campuses for each of their respective systems. Data submitted separately in Fiscal Years 1991 and 1992 for UCLA are now incorporated into the Univ. of California System response. Data submitted separately in Fiscal Years 1991 and 1992 for SUNY/Buffalo are now incorporated into the response for the SUNY Research Foundation.*
11. *The total number of professional full-time equivalents ("FTEs") and staff support FTEs for both technology transfer and those in support of licensing activities may be understated by the use of FTEs employed by third-party patent management firms that were used for these services. The use of third-party patent management firms was not reported in this survey.*
12. *Direct payment of patenting costs by licensees is not included in the legal fees expended and legal fees reimbursed data.*

Attachment A**DEFINITIONS**

The following definitions were used to clarify these data elements requested on the "AUTM Licensing Survey."

Startup Company: As used in this survey, a company that was dependent upon licensing the institution's technology for initiation.

Eligible FTEs: Persons employed in the office of technology transfer and, in rare instances, those whose duties are *specifically assigned* to supporting technology transfer activities, i.e., an industrial liaison, intellectual property counsel, but not persons employed in an office of sponsored programs.

Technology Transfer: Technology Transfer includes those activities associated with both technology licensing (see definition below) and industry research agreements.

Technology Licensing: Technology Licensing includes activities associated with the evaluation and marketing of technology (including trademarks but not university's insignia) and intellectual property management, and those of license administration. It does not include activities associated with industry research agreements.

Industry Expenditures: Industry Expenditures include total expenditures made by the institution in support of its research activities funded by *corporations*, but not expenditures supported by other sources such as foundations and other nonprofit organizations.

Royalties: Royalties include: license issue fees, payments under options, annual minimums, running royalties, termination payments, the amount of equity received when cashed-in, and software end user license fees equal to \$1,000 or more, but not research funding, patent reimbursement fees, a valuation of equity not cashed-in, software end user license fees less than \$1,000, or trademark licensing royalties from university insignia.

Royalties Paid to Other Institutions: Royalties Paid to Other Institutions is a subset of gross royalties received and should not be subtracted from the total. This number will be used to better define the double-count of royalties received under this survey.

Total U. S. Patent Applications Filed: Total U. S. Patent Applications Filed includes any filing during the year requested, including continuations-in-part (CIPs), continuations, divisionals, and reissues.

New U. S. Patent Applications Filed: New U. S. Patent Applications Filed is a subset of Total U. S. Patent Applications filed. It does not include continuations, divisionals, or reissues, and typically does not include CIPs. A CIP may only be counted as a new invention if filed with substantially new matter.

Patents Issued: Total number of U.S. patents issued to the institution in the year requested.

Management Firms. Attachments B and C of this Executive Summary provide the Table of Contents of the full report and a listing of the tables contained in each section, respectively.

To assist technology managers in selecting institutions that are comparable to their own institution, a column has been added to the tables in the full report to indicate whether or not the institution has a Medical School. Tables for Canadian Institutions have been modified, when necessary, to include two separate columns: one for U.S. dollar totals and a second for Canadian dollar totals.⁶

The AUTM Licensing Survey collects information on major variables associated with licensing activities. Each of these values has risen consistently from Fiscal Year 1991 to 1993.⁷ Some examples include: invention disclosures received, which increased from 6,337 to 8,581; U.S. patent applications filed, with 2,476 filed in FY 1991 as compared to 3,835 in FY 1993; and licenses & options executed, which rose from 1,257 to 2,227 over this period. Gross royalties received have also increased from \$186 million in Fiscal Year 1991 to \$323 million for Fiscal Year 1993.⁸ These increases are a reflection of both the improved performance by technology transfer programs and greater participation in the AUTM Licensing Survey; the latter evidenced by 130 participating institutions in Fiscal Years 1991 and 1992, as compared to 158 organizations in FY 1993.

Summary totals for Fiscal Year 1993 are noted in Attachment D,⁹ and selected data from the full report are provided in Attachment E.^{10,11,12} The last report in this Executive Summary, included as Attachment F, presents comparative totals by sample population for the Fiscal Years 1993, 1992, and 1991.

NOTES

1. *An AUTM regular member is defined by the "By-Laws of the Association of University Technology Managers, Inc." under Article I: Categories of Memberships, and includes: a) institutions of higher education or teaching hospitals; and b) individuals regularly engaged by such institutions to manage their intellectual property.*
2. *As defined by AUTM By-Laws, affiliate members include those organizations other than institutions of higher education or teaching hospitals, such as not-for-profit research firms, profit-making organizations, government agencies, etc., that manage intellectual property and interact with institutions of higher education or teaching hospitals.*
3. *Tables showing data for Fiscal Years 1993, 1992, and 1991 reflect all organizations that participated in the AUTM Licensing Survey for these years. Tables presenting data for only Fiscal Year 1993 or Fiscal Years 1991 and 1992 reflect only those institutions that participated in the survey for those years, respectively.*
4. *Consistent with the reporting of U.S. Hospitals and nonprofit institutions in other similar reports, i.e., the United States Patents Issued to Universities and Nonprofit Organizations report produced by The Research Foundation of SUNY/Buffalo, and at the request of some AUTM members, data for research institutes have been combined with U.S. Hospitals in this report.*

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
