Proposed OMB Circular - "Patents - Small Business Firms and Nonprofit Organizations" to Supersede OMB Bulletin 81-22

In response to your memorandum of January 4, 1982, the proposed Circular supersedes interim Bulletin 81-22 implementing P.L. 96-517. There are no "major policy decisions" to be made. The Circular is consistent with this Administration's position on the Schmidt Bill (S. 1657) which extends the application of P.L. 96-517 to all funding agreement recipients. The end result will be to give all recipients of contracts, grants and cooperative agreements with limited exceptions a first right of refusal to title in inventions made with Government support. This Circular gives as directed by P.L. 96-517 such rights to nonprofit organizations, including universities, and small businesses. The Circular in most part is responsive to the over 130 public and agency comments received on the Bulletin.

The <u>Federal Register</u> notice to accompany the Circular is attached to the abstract of correspondence (item c) and summarizes the resolution of issues raised by agency and public comments under the following major issue headings:
