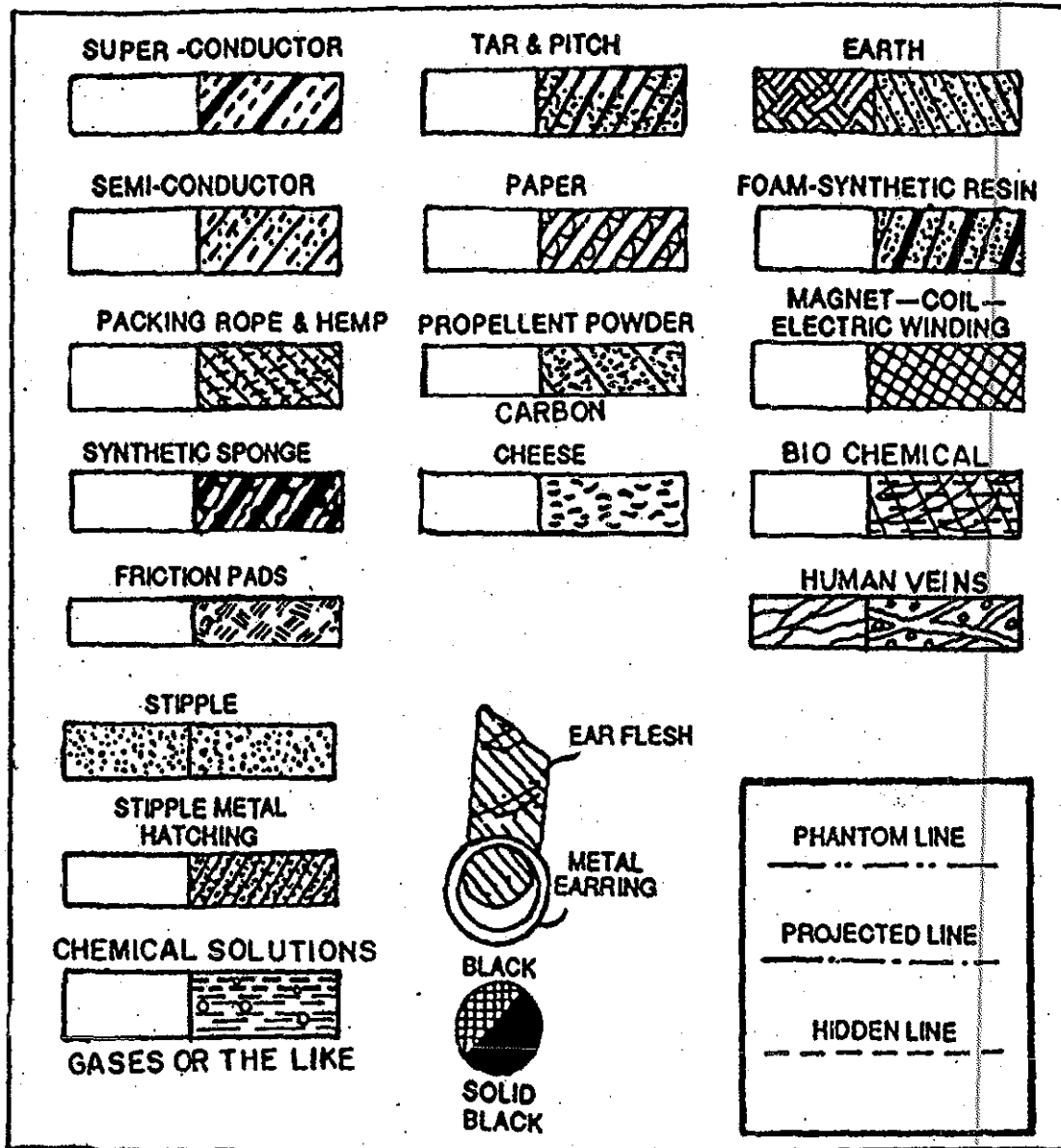


608.02(a) New Drawing — When Replacement is Required Before Examination

ings in utility and plant applications filed on or after November 29, 2000, other than continued prosecution applications (CPAs), will be reviewed by the Office of Initial Patent Examination (OIPE) for compliance with certain requirements of 37 CFR 1.84. OIPE will send a Notice to File Corrected Application Papers if the drawings are not acceptable for purposes of publication. The notice will give applicant a time period of 2 months from the mailing date of the notice to file
