
Dear Mr. Pike:

This is to acknowledge and thank you for your telegram of Sept. 21 regarding H.R. 12112, the synthetic fuels bill. I appreciate your contacting me on this legislation.

As you know, on Sept. 23 the House voted on the rule to consider H.R. 12112 and this resolution was defeated by a vote of 192 to 193. You will be interested to know that I voted in support of the rule to consider this legislation. As you can see by the vote, the House was very divided on the question of government support at this time for the development of synthetic fuels.
