
Gentlemen:

This is to acknowledge and thank you for your letter of March 14 regarding your strong support for H.R. 2414, legislation which would amend Title 35 of the U.S. Code to establish uniform federal patent procedures for small businesses and to create patent ability for some nonprofit organizations.
