Thank you for writing to Howard Bremer. I think SUPA, in cooperation with the Patent and Trademark Office, can help tremendously.

One of the things, specifically, that obviously must be done is to introduce the patent system to our universities--and especially those that have technical schools. It strikes me as strange, indeed, that a young engineer can complete his technical curriculum without ever having seen a patent.
