The Inventions and Contributions Board has considered the subject petition at its meeting of 20 November 1973, and has determined that favorable findings may be made under appropriate provisions of the NASA Waiver Regulations (1972). The Board proposes to recommend to the Administrator of NASA that waiver of domestic rights be granted.

The Board does not consider the reference to foreign rights made in the petition, page 3, item (e), as a request for waiver of foreign rights. A petition for foreign rights should be made in accordance with Section 1245.106 of the Waiver Regulations. Petitioner is encouraged to use the attached Petition for Waiver form for requesting waiver of foreign rights. The form need not be submitted while the petition for waiver of domestic rights is pending. It may be submitted when Petitioner has definitely decided that it will file patent applications in foreign countries.

You will be notified of the Administrator's action on the requested waiver of domestic rights in due course.
