Dear Mrs. Pixius:

In recent weeks I have had several conversations with Mr. Bruce Dahlbo of Dr. Dvorkovitz and Associates. He indicated that the European Patent Office will have a booth at the 1979 Technology Fair in Atlanta the latter part of February, and further, that its representatives will be in the United States to provide information to potential users of your organization.

The Society of University Patent Administrators, a three-year-old organization with about 100 members from the major research universities in the United States and Canada, will hold its annual meeting on Monday, February 26, 1979 to coincide with the Dvorkovitz Fair. I am the program chairman for that annual meeting and am seeking speakers on important and timely topics.
