SUBJECT: Revised Government Data Policy Statement

Enclosed are the following:

This revision, which supersedes ones dated April 11, March 27, etc., is considerably different from the one furnished by Milton's memo of March 7, 1985. As suggested by the attached enclosed NASA letter, it is recast as a policy statement rather than as an operational regulation. But, whereas the statement proposed by NASA is aimed only at contracts, the OPTI version covers both kinds of awards, and proposes distinct policies for each.
