
Gentlemen:

Thank you for your recent letter stating your support for H.R. 2414, a bill to amend existing patent procedures to promote the marketing of inventions developed under federally supported research projects by nonprofit organizations and small business firms. I am a cosponsor of H.R. 2414.

H.R. 2414 has been referred to the House Judiciary Committee's Subcommittee on Courts, Civil Liberties, and the Administration of Justice. The Subcommittee, of which I am a member, has held a number of hearings, the latest of which was on May 8, 1980.
