Dear Mr. Lasken:

This letter will have reference to the letter you received from Mr. R. E. Gentry dated July 16, 1973 listing information needed to support the request for an Institutional Patent Agreement.

As I mentioned to you on the telephone item 9. (d) on page 4 of Mr. Gentry's letter which purports to give the gross royalty income is an error. The figures presented in column (d) represent the net royalty income for the years specified rather than the gross royalty income. We are embarrassed by this oversight and have been unable to reconstruct why the net figures were given to you. To correct this error we are listing below the gross royalty figures for the years 1963 through 1970. In 1971 the Foundation converted to a fiscal year basis from a calendar year basis and therefore the gross royalty income for 1971 is not readily available. By telephone I did give you the fiscal year gross royalty income for 1972 and 1973 along with the net figure as well as the net net royalty figure.
