Thank you for your letter of May 2 and the draft of the report on the survey of university patent policies.

I think that your plan to distribute a copy of the report to the research oriented universities and to supply Norm Latker with a copy is a good one. I too believe that although there are some parts of the report, particularly the answer to question 28, which might be beneficial for some in Government agencies to see, in general I think a very limited distribution within the Government would be more appropriate.

One other suggestion is that perhaps a copy should be made available to NSF also although I do not feel very strongly about that.
