Thank you for your letter of May 10, 1979 and your interest in the SUPA organization and in some of the technology which exists within the universities represented by the SUPA membership.

Unfortunately SUPA has no breakdown as to the specific technology available from each of the universities with which its members may be affiliated. At best we can send you a list of the SUPA members which, by a copy of this letter I am asking our Secretary, Mary Spores, to do, and it would then be up to you to contact each of those persons to indicate your Company's interests.
