Thanks for your letter of November 1 and the revised Invention Record and Report form. The only suggestion that we have would be in numbered item 7 to delete the word "received" and insert in its place the word "used." In this way we thought we might avoid the individual interpretation of the word received as defining receipt of approval of a grant and indicate that mention should be made of any and all monies used by the principal investigator, or any people working under his direction, during the time the invention was conceived and/or reduced to practice.
