Dear Bob:

In a recent discussion with Mr. John Raubitschek of the National Science Foundation he told me that NSF and DHEW had jointly agreed that both agencies should be recognized in any license to the Government under inventions supported by them jointly. He also indicated that they had no preconceived notion about the form of the license and that either the DHEW or NSF form would be acceptable. In addition such jointly supported inventions are to be reported to both agencies.

We have marked our records to take care of the foregoing in the normal course of our operations. We already recognize multiple support in the patent application where that condition pertains.
