This will advise you that at this time the Foundation does not wish to attempt to obtain any rights from the Surgeon General relative to the above invention. It is our understanding that the invention has thus far not been described in any publication; nor has a manuscript been submitted for publication purposes.

In view of the above it would appear that there would be an opportunity for WARF to re-evaluate its position at sometime in the future. Then, providing no publication has been made which would constitute a statutory bar against patenting, a suitable development statement could be filed with the Surgeon General requesting permission for WARF to patent and license the invention. At this time, we do not feel any such move is justified.
