
I appreciated receiving your correspondence expressing your support for the Small Business, Nonprofit Organization Patent Procedures Act.

This bill was introduced in the Senate on September 13, by Senator Dole. S. 3496 would amend Title 35 of the United States Code, to establish a uniform Federal patent procedure for small businesses and nonprofit organizations, to create a consistent policy and procedure concerning patentability of inventions made with Federal assistance. The Senate Judiciary Committee is presently working on this important matter of concern to you.
