I have read and re-read your letter several times. It is well thought out and I can't disagree with it in any respect.

As you can see stationary is now available to the present officers of SUPA. Frankly, I didn't remember all the officers myself. Although I can't speak for the others (and besides I think my term will be up come February), I see no reason why those in office should not resign in order to have an open election. However, unless the membership is of a reasonable number it may make little difference.
