Dear Milt:

1. In connection with the FOIA rule change, it would appear that an amendment should be made so that the originator of a proposal is notified if DHSS determines that it can ignore a proposer's restrictive legend and makes the proposal contents available under FOIA. The proposer should be notified of such a determination sufficiently in advance of DHSS making the proposal available so that appropriate steps can be taken to either appeal or seek intellectual property protection. Six months might be a reasonable time.

The text of the proposed rule could use some editing in Paragraph 3-1, 353(d)(2) to put the actual legend required in quotation marks.

2. In connection with the DOE patent licensing regulations, they appear to apply only to patents held by DOE; thus a comment by COGR is probably not warranted.

May we be notified as soon as convenient the date and the location of the next subcommittee meeting?
