There has been considerable interest in developing information about patented inventions that have originated in universities. Among others, Mr. Thornton, the Chairman of the House Subcommittee on Domestic and International Scientific Planning and Analysis, expressed such an interest at the hearing at which I testified. The Department of Commerce, in the office of the Assistant Secretary for Science and Technology, has urged that SUPA collect such information and has arranged for assistance from the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office. The latter has provided a list of all patents issued since 1967 (sometimes 1969) to the top ranking 50 research universities plus any others having DHEW Institutional Patent Agreements.

Enclosed herewith is a set of questionnaire forms for the patents which the Patent Office has associated with your institution, either because the patent was assigned to you, to an affiliated research foundation, or to Research Corporation. Research Corporation kindly participated by providing patent numbers and dates on the patents assigned to them.

Your completion of the enclosed questionnaires and return would be appreciated. Please also complete one of the questionnaire forms enclosed for any patent which is not listed on the Patent Office printout. The Patent Office was not able, for example, to identify patents assigned to the Federal or State Governments, Industry, some Patent Management Organizations, and others.

Please be assured that any information you disclose in these questionnaires will not be associated with your institution in any dissemination or publication that results.

I hope that the above and the enclosures will be clear. If further information is needed, please let me know.
