Dear Senator Leahy:

I am writing as a follow-up to my telephone conversations with John Podesta regarding pending legislation to extend the Bayh-Dole bill that led to P.L. 96-517. We at the University of Vermont support the proposed extensions including extension of patent rights to large business concerns, eliminating the limitation on exclusive licensing, and having the Department of Commerce responsible for regulations governing patents rather than the Office of Management and Budget. My colleague, Mr. Roger Ditzel (Chairman of the Patents, Copyrights, and Rights in Data Committee of Council on Governmental Relations) informed me that his Committee supports the above developments as well. Accordingly, I ask you to consider supporting the preparation of new legislation in regard to the above as well as serving as a co-sponsor of a bill introduced to the Senate.

Thank you for your consideration and cooperation in the above matters.
