Thank you for writing to express your interest in H.R. 6444, the Patent Term Restoration Act. This bill was developed as the result of four years of study of ways in which Government patent policy can be changed to stimulate industrial innovation.

The Committee on the Judiciary reported H.R. 6444 on August 4, 1982. It is now scheduled to go to the floor for a vote on September 13.
