The main purpose of this letter is to inquire about the status of our petition for an institutional agreement. I have had certain interim reports from Mr. Bremer of WARF indicating that you are working on the agreement. I thought some of the questions might be resolved by now.

May I also take this opportunity to thank you for your valiant efforts in the Sih case. WARF is still working with a number of companies to discover whether there is any extant interest, given the terms of the determination, or whether during the long interval since the announcement of the discovery, companies have proceeded on their own. I have asked WARF to give me a complete report within the next few weeks and the next time I am in Washington, I will seek an appointment with you to review the present status of this.

Thanks again for your efforts in the Sih matter and could we look forward in the near future to an institutional arrangement.
