Subject: Meeting with Professor Young, September 3, 1964.

The following actions are required as a result of this meeting:

1. WARP to advise University of its willingness to reassign Coenzyme Q patent to the Government. Ward will draft a letter which will set forth for the record the deficiencies of the Surgeon General's determination on this case and point out the serious consequences of these.
2. WARP will advise University of its decision regarding the Litzers-Friedman invention. This decision is that we should not proceed with an attempt to obtain rights from the Surgeon General.
3. WARP to provide pertinent information to enable University to check the source of research funds which led to the making of the Maloney-Davis invention.
4. WARP will request Herb to report, through his Dean, the "ribbon filament" invention so that University may request a determination from the NSF whereby WARP may have ownership of this invention. The Government would have a royalty-free, non-revocable, non-exclusive license.
