

HIGHLIGHTS OF FEDERAL TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER

- ◆ 1964 - DHEW inventions not reaching the marketplace.
- ◆ 1968 - Disputes over Federally funded inventions
- ◆ 1968 - G.A.O. Report.
- ◆ 1969 - DHEW patent policy changed.
- ◆ 1973 - First technology transfer Association formed
- ◆ 1976 - First gene splicing patent licensed

TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER LEGISLATION

- ◆ 1977 - DHEW reassesses 1969 patent policy changes.
- ◆ 1977 - Universities press for legislation.
- ◆ 1980 - Bayh-Dole enacted.
- ◆ 1983 - Executive order extends Bayh-Dole.
- ◆ 1986 - Federal Technology Transfer Act enacted.
