Dear

Dr. Betsy Ancker-Johnson has suggested that the Sponsored Research Visiting Committee might find it useful and valuable to look at Stanford's track record and policies for patents and patent licensing in comparison with Massachusetts Institute of Technology's which you received earlier this year. The information we have been able to get from Stanford is attached.

You will note that their gross income is about one-third what we are presently realizing. Their research volume is approximately 90% of M.I.T.'s on-campus volume, or 45% of M.I.T.'s volume including Lincoln Laboratory.
