Dear Mr. Latker:

I have recently had several exchanges of correspondence with Senators Gaylord Nelson (Wisconsin) and Russell Long (Louisiana) on the assignment by HEW of patent rights to institutions such as Wistar. I recently received this relatively long response from Senator Russell which indicates that he is taking a very hard line against any such policy in the absence of specific authority derived from legislation.

I have no way of knowing whether his view will prevail; in any case, institutions such as Wistar which have benefited from HEW policy may find themselves the innocent victims of an attack primarily directed elsewhere.
