Thank you for your letter regarding H.R. 6249. This bill has been jointly referred to the Judiciary and Science and Technology Committees. Although the Judiciary Committee has no action planned for the near future, there is a good chance that Mr. Thornton will schedule hearings before his Subcommittee sometime this month.

The Senate passed S. 2255 during the 94th Congress. The House did not take any action in this regard. Although copies of the Senate bill are no longer available for distribution, I am enclosing the Congressional Record for that day (February 26, 1976). The pages are marked.
