The name of the author is not given in the copyright line, but it does appear on the title page and, in fact, is the only name that appears anywhere on the copies. It is their opinion, therefore, that registration should be made but that applicant should be advised as to a better form of notice in the future.

Mrs. Brady, on the other hand, feels that the notice is inadequate in that the name has been omitted therefrom and also that L. Harvey is not designated as author in any place on the copies.
