It is the opinion of Mr. Smith and Mr. Wise that the notice of copyright is adequate. It is under the title and is clearly applicable to all copyrightable component parts of the work, which, in this case, consists only of the print. Mrs. Brady, on the other hand, feels that the application should be rejected because the notice of copyright does not appear on the face of the print.
