Question: Adequacy of copyright notice.

The notice of copyright which appears on the copies is in the following form: "Hamilton-39
Copyrighted"

It is the opinion of Mr. Wise, Mr. Smith, and Mr. Pierce that registration should be made as applied for, and the applicant advised that in the future his full name should be included as a part of the copyright notice, or in the event the initials are used with the symbol "C" in a circle the full name must appear some place upon the copies. Mrs. Brady, on the other hand, takes the position that the use of the surname alone in the copyright notice is inadequate, and that the application should be rejected accordingly.
