
Title: "Close to My Heart"

Question: Division of opinion as to adequacy of application.

The application filed gives the following statement with respect to composership in space (3): Mrs. H. Lane, melody based on Johannes Brahms "Cradle Song" written 1835. The name of the author is given in space (6) as Mrs. H. Lane. On the copy the following statement appears "Words and arranged by Mrs. H. Lane, part of melody from Johannes Brahms 'Cradle Song'."

The examiner urges that a new application be filed with a statement in space (3) reading as follows: Composer and arranger. She suggests that "based on Johannes Brahm's 'Cradle Song'" be given in space (7) after the title. Mrs. Brady supports the examiner in this recommendation. Mr. Wise and Mr. Smith, on the other hand, feel that the application filed gives all of the information required to make the registration, and they vote accordingly for registration as applied for.
