The application gives the name of the copyright owner as Fred C. Schram.

Mr. Pierce is of the opinion that registration should be made in the name of Fred C. Schram, and a letter addressed to him pointing out that in the future the elements of the notice should be more closely associated. Mr. Smith takes the position that the Office should write and inquire whether Fred C. Schram is the sole owner of the Schram Printing Co. If not, the application should be rejected. Mrs. Brady, on the other hand, supports the examiner in rejection the application on the ground that the notice of copyright lacks the name of the copyright owner.
