MEMORANDUM

Remitter: Edmund C. Rogers (31028)--Class G? K?

Title: "Live American Get on Payrolls" and "Live American Vote Guard Our Peace."

Question: Division of opinion as to whether statement of publication made by attorney is acceptable.

The applicant in his letter of June 24 in the second paragraph makes the following statement concerning this work:

"In your letter of June 10 you remark that it is possible that the matter has been published in a better edition. The original copies, however, still represent the best edition and the original publication date of August 9, 1939 is still the proper date of publication."

In the opinion of Mr. Pierce this statement should be accepted and registration made under class K, especially in view of the subject matter of the work which justifies registration in this category. Mrs. Brady and Mr. Smith, on the other hand, take the position that registration should not be made as class K. They feel that registration should be requested under class G2 since publication does not appear to have taken place. The application on form G1 with copies in their present form would not be appropriate. Note, the suggestion for registration as an unpublished drawing is not applicable in the case of "Live American Vote Get on Payrolls" which has already been so copyrighted.
