Title: "The Find Your Name Puzzle Contest"
Question: Division of opinion as to whether material filed is susceptible of publication.

The material submitted is obviously prepared for distribution to solicit trade, the object being to present in graphic form the fundamentals of "Find your Name Puzzle," which is designed to be run at intervals in newspapers, periodicals, etc.

In the opinion of Mr. Wise and Mr. Pierce publication takes place when the material is sent out in the mail to solicit business. It is the only distribution that takes place and any prospective purchaser can doubtless acquire copies. Mrs. Brady, on the other hand, feels that the application should be rejected because protection is sought for an idea or plan, and furthermore, in her opinion publication is not effected by the distribution of copies to solicit trade.
