

Question: Sufficiency of address of claimant given on application  
as follows: "University of Lucknow, India."

The Statesman's Year Book identifies the location of this University, The University of Lucknow, with the city of Lucknow. It is listed in the Year Book with the five other unitary and residential universities in British India, all of which bear the names of the cities in which they are located, i.e., Allahabad, Rangoon, Dacca, Delhi, and Annemalai. I think therefore that the address in the application may be sufficient for locating the author and claimant at the present time, this being the Ad Interim. However, I should like Mr. Howell's approval of its sufficiency, as the question may arise if the American Edition is published giving the author as claimant.
